

My activities in the last six months after attending 3rd CIPRE Mid-career Training Seminar “Roles of different actors in the policy and decision-making process”

First of all I have presented the materials from CIPRE seminar to my colleagues from Supreme Council for Science and Technological Development of the Republic of Moldova and discuss with them the issues presented at seminar.

I proposed that research-development projects presented at national competition to be evaluated by experts from abroad (like in Serbia), but so far it was not possible.

The materials and experience were used in preparation of some legislative acts:

- in elaboration of the project of the law on evaluation and accreditation of research-development institutions (especially materials of F.Gault);
- in elaboration of the proposes for science sector in the Strategy for economic development and combating poverty;
- decision of the Government on creation State Agency for technological transfer constituted from 20 persons.

The gained experience was indirectly used in other activities:

- accession of the Republic of Moldova to Science and Technology center in Ukraine which is financed by European Union, United States and Canada;
- organization of a Moldavian-Germany Seminar on innovations and technological transfer;
- organization of a series of informational events related participation of moldavian researchers in Sixth Framework Program and INTAS calls etc.

I appreciate that gained experience at seminar was very useful also in my day by day activities.
